

5 Easy Steps

To becoming a Habitat Homeowner

Step 1

Pre-application

Complete and return the attached Pre-application to the Habitat office along with ***required documents**. The Selection Committee will review your application and conduct a credit and background check.

Step 2

Formal Application

If your credit and income are adequate, you will come to the Habitat Office for a full application meeting. You will need to bring in important documents. We will also complete a budget to assess ability to pay.

Step 3

Home Visit and “Good Faith Hours”

Selection Committee will visit you at your home to meet your family and see where you are currently living. Afterwards you will be asked to complete 10 “Good Faith Hours.”

Step 4

Selection Committee Review

Your application and all documentation will be reviewed by the Selection Committee and presented to the Board of Directors.

Step 5

Board of Directors Approval

After completing the application, supplying all requested documentation, and review by the Selection Committee, your application will be presented to and approved or denied by the Board of Directors of Habitat for Humanity Georgetown County.

Requirements to become a Habitat Homeowner

- Need
- Ability to Pay
- Willingness to Partner with Habitat (including 300 Sweat Equity Hours)

Qualifications for Homeownership

Residency

You must have lived in Georgetown County for the last 12 months.

You must be an American citizen, legal resident, or have the right to work in the United States.

Housing Need

If your housing situation includes one or more of the following, please complete and return the attached application.

Substandard

You have broken plumbing, faulty or unsafe electrical service, and/or poor heating, etc.

Unsafe

If there are multiple crime-related police calls in your neighborhood.

Cost Burdened

If your rental payments are 35% or more of your total income.

Overcrowded

Adult and child or more than two children share a bedroom, or two children of the opposite sex share a bedroom.

Income

You must have a steady source of income that is between the minimum and maximum income for your family size. This chart shows the current income figures.

Credit

You must maintain good credit. We will check your credit history by running a credit report. Credit checks will be conducted periodically until the closing on your house. You have the right to request a copy of your credit report.

*Documents

When you return this pre-application **YOU MUST BRING:**

- Payroll forms for **all** working members of the family for the last 60 days
- IRS tax returns for the last two years
- Documentation of any other income you receive such as SSI, SS, disability, etc.
- **\$20** Application fee for background/credit checks

If you are accepted to complete a full application, you will be notified to bring in these documents:

- Photo IDs and Social Security cards for all family members
